NOTICE OF MAKING OF ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION RELATING TO GADBROOK PARK, NORTHWICH

Planning Control over changes of use from Class E (commercial, business and service) of Schedule 2 to the Use Classes Order (as amended) to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses)

Cheshire West and Chester Council ("The Council") made a non-immediate Article 4 Direction on 30 July 2026 under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015, as amended.

The Direction relates to development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within class E (commercial, business and service) of Part A of Schedule 2 to the Town and Country (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) to a use falling within C3 (dwellinghouses, used as sole or main residence) of Part 3 of Schedule 1 to the Town and Country (Use Classes) 1987 (as amended) being development comprised within Class MA of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Order and not being development comprised within any other class.

The Article 4 Direction applies to Gadbrook Park, Northwich. A copy of the Direction, including a map defining the area covered can be viewed at the following locations:
